AVAILABLE PROGRAMS

24/7 Crisis Assessment

A comprehensive mental health assessment will be provided by a master's level clinician at no charge.

Adult Inpatient Psychiatric Program

Serves patients ages 18 and older with acute symptoms of psychiatric illness who require a safe therapeutic environment to support recovery from acute mental health conditions.

Adult Inpatient Detox Program

This program provides medical detoxification for alcohol, opioids, stimulants, prescription medications, or illicit drugs to people age 18 and older.

Adult Inpatient Dual Diagnosis Program

Treats co-occurring behavioral health conditions and substance use disorders. This program is designed to stabilize each patient's psychiatric symptoms and engage them in the recovery process. Evidence-based treatment modalities are used to support each patient's continued recovery.

Adolescent Inpatient Psychiatric Program

Provides acute care to youth ages 13 to 17 who are in need of mental health and behavioral health treatment.



Chicago Behavioral Hospital provides services that meet the distinct needs of the community. Programs include:



Senior Adult Program

For senior adults in crisis and in need of immediate behavioral health stabilization. This program addresses depression, bipolar disorder, schizophrenia, Alzheimer's disease accompanied by behavioral issues and other mental illnesses occurring during the aging process.

OUTPATIENT PROGRAMS

Adolescent Partial Hospitalization Program (PHP)

Provides outpatient therapeutic and psychoeducational groups for youth ages 13 to 17 experiencing mental or behavioral health symptoms that require more intensive treatment than traditional outpatient therapy or counseling. This program can also function as transitional care following inpatient treatment.

Adult Intensive Outpatient Programs (IOP)

CBH offers multiple intensive outpatient groups for adults experiencing symptoms related to mental health and/or substance use concerns.





Women's Inpatient Psychiatric Program

This program addresses mental health issues that are specific to women, including depression, anxiety, bipolar disorder, mood and anxiety disorders during pregnancy or post-partum, post-traumatic stress disorder, and other trauma-related mental health issues.

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
