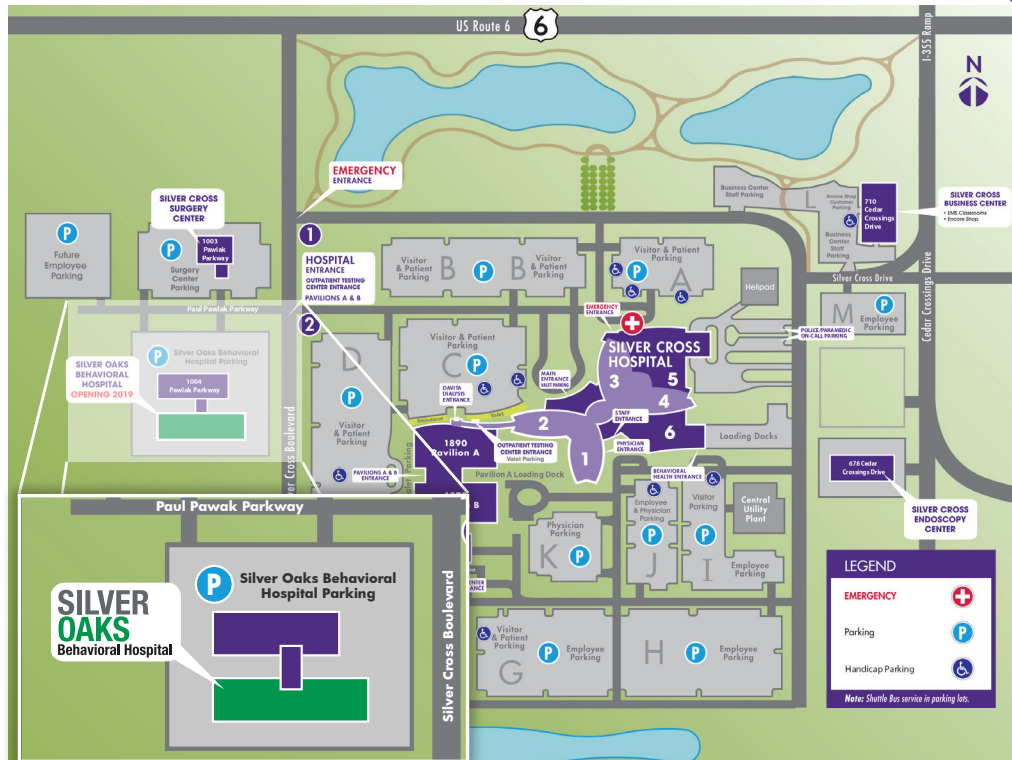

From the North (off I-55)

Take I-55 South to I-355 South. Exit onto Southwest Hwy, (Rt. 6/Maple Road) and turn right. Turn left onto Silver Cross Boulevard.

From the South (off I-55)

Take I-55 North to I-80 East. Exit on I-355 North. Exit onto Southwest Hwy, (Rt. 6/Maple Road) and turn right. Turn left onto Silver Cross Boulevard.

From the East (off I-80)

Take I-80 West to I-355 North. Exit onto Southwest Hwy, (Rt. 6/Maple Road) and turn right. Turn left onto Silver Cross Boulevard.

From the West (off I-80)

Take I-80 East to I-355 North. Exit onto Southwest Hwy, (Rt. 6/Maple Road) and turn right. Turn left onto Silver Cross Boulevard.

AVAILABLE PROGRAMS

24/7 Crisis Assessment

A comprehensive mental health assessment will be provided by a Master's level prepared clinician at no charge.

Adult Inpatient Psychiatric Program

Services patients ages 18 and older with acute symptoms of psychiatric illness who require a safe therapeutic environment to support recovery from acute mental health conditions.

Adult Inpatient Detox and Substance Use Disorder Treatment Program

This program provides medical detoxification and treatment for alcohol, opioids, stimulants, prescription drugs, or illicit drugs to those 18 years old or older.

Adult Inpatient Dual Diagnosis

Treats behavioral health conditions along with substance use disorder or addiction ailments. The program stabilizes each patient's psychiatric symptoms, as well as engages them in the recovery process. All treatment follows evidence-based modalities and is used to support each patient's continued recovery.



SPECIALTY PROGRAMS

Silver Oaks will provide services that meet the distinct needs of the community. Programs in the future may include:



Senior Adult Program

For senior adults in crisis and in need of immediate behavioral health stabilization. The program addresses depression, bipolar disorder, schizophrenia, Alzheimer's disease accompanied by behavioral issues and other mental illnesses occurring during the aging process.

OUTPATIENT PROGRAMS

Partial Hospitalization Program

This program provides outpatient therapeutic and educational sessions organized at various levels of intensity and frequency. The Partial Hospitalization Program is for persons who are experiencing mental or behavioral health conditions that do not necessitate residential or inpatient care. The program functions as an alternative to inpatient care, or as transitional care following an inpatient stay.

Intensive Outpatient Program

The Intensive Outpatient Program provides similar clinical services as the Partial Hospitalization Program with less frequency.

Adolescent Inpatient Psychiatric Program

Provides acute care to youth ages 13 to 17 who are in need of mental health and behavioral health care treatment.
